



Following plant and plant products, originating in third countries, are subject to the phytosanitary import control at the 1st point of entry in the EU according to the Directive 2000/29/EC:

Below mentioned plants and plant products shall be accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate in original.

Please note that in case of forwarding consignments to other EU member states, additional requirements for protected zones can apply.

Wood, bark and wood packaging material are not included in this list.

- all plants, intended for planting (without prejudice to the prohibitions applicable to the plants listed in Annex III), other than seeds, but including
- seeds of:
 - Cruciferae, Gramineae, Trifolium* spp., originating in Argentina, Australia, Bolivia, Chile, New Zealand and Uruguay
 - Triticum, Secale, x Triticosecale*, originating in Afghanistan, India, Iran, Iraq, Mexico, Nepal, Pakistan, South Africa and the USA
 - Capsicum* spp., *Helianthus annuus, Medicago sativa, Prunus, Rubus, Solanum lycopersicum, Oryza* spp., *Zea mays, Allium ascalonicum, Allium cepa, Allium porrum, Allium schoenoprasum, Phaseolus, Pinus, Pseudotsuga menziesii*
- parts of plants, other than fruits and seeds:
 - Castanea, Dendranthema, Dianthus, Gypsophila, Pelargonium, Phoenix* spp., *Populus, Quercus, Solidago, Coniferales, Amyris, Casimiroa, Citropsis, Eremocitrus, Esenbeckia, Glycosmis, Merrillia, Naringi, Tetradium, Toddalia, Zanthoxylum*
 - Acer saccharum*, originating in the USA and Canada
 - Prunus*, originating in non-European countries
- cut branches of *Betula*, with or without foliage
- cut branches of *Fraxinus, Juglans ailantifolia, Juglans mandshurica, Ulmus davidiana, Pterocarya rhoifolia*, with or without foliage, originating in Canada, China, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Republic of Korea, Japan, Mongolia, Russia, Taiwan and the USA
- cut flowers of *Orchidaceae*
- cut flowers of *Aster* spp., *Eryngium, Hypericum, Lisianthus, Rosa* and *Trachelium*, originating in non-European countries
- leafy vegetables of *Apium graveolens, Ocimum, Limnophila* and *Eryngium*
- leaves of *Manihot esculenta*
- fruits of:
 - Citrus, Fortunella, Poncirus, Microcitrus, Naringi, Swinglea* and their hybrids
- fruits of:
 - Capsicum, Momordica, Solanum melongena* and *Solanum lycopersicum*
- fruits of *Solanum aethiopicum* and *Solanum macrocarpon* originating in Africa or in the Americas
 - Annona, Cydonia, Diospyros, Malus, Mangifera, Passiflora, Prunus, Psidium, Pyrus, Ribes, Syzygium* and *Vaccinium*, originating in non-European countries



- fruits of *Punica granatum*, originating in countries of the African continent, Cape Verde, Saint Helena, Madagascar, La Réunion, Mauritius and Israel
- potatoes (without prejudice to the prohibitions applicable to the plants listed in Annex III)
- soil (the import of soil with origin in certain countries is prohibited)
- grain of the genera *Triticum*, *Secale*, *x Triticosecale* originating in Afghanistan, India, Iran, Iraq, Mexico, Nepal, Pakistan, South Africa and the USA
- parts of plants, other than fruits and seeds of
